## 36th D.L.I. RALLY

PLEASE READ THIS FORM CAREFULLY

The North East Military Vehicle Club Ltd. in conjunction with the Durham Light Infantry Museum and Art Gallery are holding the **36th Rally of Historic Military Vehicles** over the August Bank Holiday weekend of **Sunday 30th and Monday 31st August 2009**

We would once again like you to join us at Durham for our annual show. We will again be using both sides of the show site up to the County Hall and hope to have around sixty vehicles.

As before members with vehicles will be allowed free entry to the museum - but ONLY if you are wearing your Exhibitors badge (they are circular, dark green with gold lettering). There will be some available at the club tent. Please follow this instruction and don't give the museum staff a hard time, they won't let you in without it. All military vehicles are welcome and the camping is free.

We ask that your vehicles be **on the show site by 9.30am at the latest**, as the public will be allowed in at 10am on both days - if you can help sell our programmes then please do so.

For those wanting to make a long weekend of it the site will be open from the Friday evening and the toilet key will be available from one of the Rally Marshals. We will have a club tent with lighting on site for the Saturday night barbecue (bring your own food) and we hope to offer a subsidised meal on the Sunday evening up at the Garden House for which there will be a small token charge. Please remain in the campsite area in the early hours and if you hear or see anything illegal taking place please ring the police direct, do not attempt to tackle it yourself. Generators must confirm to current Health & Safety Regs and include earthing ground spikes - the cut off time will be 11pm on both nights. If you remain in the vicinity of the club tent long after others have gone to bed, please keep your voices down and moderate your language. Keep the campsite and the museum grounds tidy and enjoy your weekend.

**Re-enactor/living History groups are requested to please wait until all the large vehicles are in position before moving on site unless you have already been allocated an area in previous agreement with the Chief Marshal. ALL SUPPORT CARS MUST BE OFF THE SHOW FIELD BEFORE 9.45am or they will be removed.**

As previously, rally marshals and site stewards have been appointed to take charge of the event and members are asked to comply with their instructions, especially regarding parking and movement on or around the grass show area. The club is liable for any damage SO NO WHEEL-SPINNING PLEASE - JEEP OWNERS ENGAGE FOUR-WHEEL DRIVE.

The local authority and the police have requested that no firearms de-activated or replica, be discharged or carried about on the showground unless attached to a vehicle as part of a display. No BB Guns are allowed.

Vehicle owners are responsible for their own security and for the conduct of members in their party. If you are bringing a dog please keep it under control at all times.
